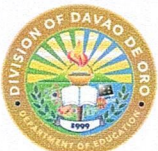
**ATTENDANCE TO THE 41st PRINCIPALS TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT



The **Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA), Inc.** will hold the 41st Principals Training and Development Program Cum National Board Conference (PTDP-NBC) from June 26 to 28, 2024, at City Coliseum, Peneyra Rd. Brgy. San Pedro, Puerto Princesa City, with the theme "Reskilling and Upskilling the School Heads on MATATAG Agenda".

The conference aims to (1) reskill the school heads on the MATATAG Curriculum; (2) upskill leadership competencies; (3) strengthen the RA 7610 Child Protection Law; and (4) develop a harmonious working relationship among school heads.

In this conference, school heads will be capacitated in implementing the mandates and prescribed practices in the following competency areas: a) school leadership, b) instructional leadership, c) creation of a student-centered learning environment, d) school management and operation, and e) personal and professional attributes, as well as interpersonal effectiveness (*see attached communication from PESPA, Inc. for further details*).

DepEd PESPA officers and board members, public school teachers, and school leaders may opt to attend the said activity provided that their participation will not hamper the conduct of classes in schools. The use of DepEd funds shall be subject to the approval of their respective approving authorities.

The same is also contingent upon its availability, and adherence to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
