

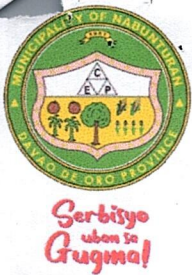

Topics to be covered	<p>Topic 1: Scriptwriting -the participants are taught in the process of creating a written document that serves as the foundation for a film. A screenplay is a specialized form of writing that communicates not only the dialogue spoken by characters but also the visual and auditory elements that make up the entire cinematic experience.</p> <p>Topic 2: Story Development - is one of the crucial phases in the filmmaking and storytelling process that the participants must learn where the initial concept evolves into a well-structured narrative. It involves shaping the characters, plot, themes, and overall arc of the story to create a compelling and engaging experience for the audience.</p> <p>Topic 3: Cinematography – the participants are taught in the art and craft of capturing images on film or digitally through the use of a camera. 
