1. Please be informed that the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Literacy Mapping will be conducted from July 3-19, 2024, in the Schools Division of Davao de Oro.
2. This activity aims to identify and gathering data on the number of out of school youth and adults in the respective School Districts; and to automate the consolidation and reporting processes.
3. All ALS Teachers, Community ALS Implementers, and Learning Facilitators are hereby directed to conduct literacy mapping within the specified timeline.
4. The Division ALS Focal and the Education Program Specialist II for ALS will monitor the conduct of the literacy mapping to ensure its successful implementation.
5. Compensatory Overtime Credits (COCs)/ Service Credits, whichever is applicable will be granted to ALS Implementers, rendering services that falls on Holidays, Saturdays, and Sundays on the period covered.
6. Travel and other incidental expenses of the attendees shall be charged against Division MOOE, School MOOE, or Local Funds, whichever is applicable, subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is hereby requested.
