BASIC INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM TRAINING

To: Division Personnel Concerned PSDS/DCP
All Others Concerned

- The Schools Division Office, under the Department of Education, is one of the key response clusters working in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGUs) during emergencies and disasters. To ensure efficient collaboration, the personnel from various sections and across governance levels must be familiar with the Incident Command System (ICS) to effectively integrate their roles and responsibilities into the overall response framework.
- 2. While some key offices have already undergone ICS training, it is now strategic to expand this knowledge to counterparts who can serve as relievers during operations. By training additional personnel, the SDO can increase the number of volunteers capable of assisting during emergency operations, strengthening its collective response capacity.
- 3. In this regard, the personnel listed in the attached document are hereby directed to attend the **Basic Incident Command System Training** scheduled on October 9-11, 2024, at the Ritz Hotel, Davao City.
