**2024 ANNUAL NATIONWIDE SEARCH FOR YOUNG ARTS SCHOLARS  
OF THE PHILIPPINE HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS**

1. The Philippine High School for the Arts (PHSA), a government-run special secondary school for young artists, is conducting the **2024 Annual Nationwide Search for Young Arts Scholars (ANSYAS)** and is now accepting applications for a full scholarship to a special K to 12 Secondary Education for School Year (SY) 2024-2025.

2. The program aims to identify and develop artistically gifted and talented children to become artists of excellence in the fields of ballet and folk dance, creative writing, music, theater, and visual arts.

3. Applicants must be Filipino citizens who can meet the following requirements:

- Outstanding ability in dance (folk or ballet), music (instrument and voice), creative writing, theater, and visual arts;
- Grade VI pupil this SY 2024-2025 in public or private school;
- Proficient in oral and written language (English and Filipino);
- Good health condition; and
- Willing to study in a boarding school.

4. The successful applicants will be awarded full scholarship, which includes free tuition fee, board and lodging, monthly stipend, individualized classes with master teachers, and a chance to represent the country in international competitions, arts festivals, and exchange programs. The scholarship is renewable every year upon satisfaction of both academic and non-academic requirements in the K to 12 curriculum.

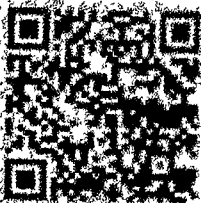
