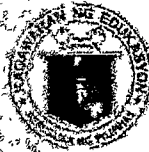

DATE : 4 October 2024

Republic Act No. 11293, also known as the Philippine Innovation Act, declared the policy of the State to foster innovation as a vital component of national development and sustainable economic growth. Section 21 of this Act provides for the establishment of the Innovation Fund, which aims to strengthen entrepreneurship and enterprises engaged in developing innovative solutions benefiting the poorest of the poor.

In line with this, the National Innovation Council (NIC) through the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) announces the Call for Proposals for the 2024 Innovation Grants which will remain open until 31 October 2024.

As per the Implementing Guidelines of the 2024 Innovation Grant, Programs/Activities/Projects (PAPs) focusing in the following areas shall be eligible for funding: *Pre-commercialization, Commercialization or Diffusion of Innovation, Innovation Facilities and Services, Innovation Culture Promotion and Capacity Building, and Innovation Policy and Administration.* Entities eligible to apply for the Grant includes National Government Agencies (NGAs), Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), Local Government Units (LGU) and State Universities and Colleges (SUCs).

As a member of the NIC, DepEd supports and disseminates this information for reference and consideration of DepEd Bureaus and Services, Regional Offices, Schools Division Offices and public schools who would like to take advantage of this funding window.



Proposals may be submitted through NEDA Electronic Innovation Grants Information System (EIGIS): <https://eigis-innovation.neda.gov.ph> on or before 31 October 2024. CONFIRMATION OF THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES ON THE 2024 INNOVATION GRANTS

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 11293, otherwise known as the Philippine Innovation Act, aims to foster innovation in the country as a vital component of national development and sustainable economic growth;

WHEREAS, paragraph 1, Section 21 of RA No. 11293 provides that the Innovation Fund is established to strengthen entrepreneurship and enterprises engaged in developing innovative solutions benefiting the poorest of the poor;

WHEREAS, paragraph 2, Section 21 of RA No. 11293 provides that subject to availability of funds, a revolving fund in the initial amount of One Billion Pesos (PHP 1,000,000,000.00), is allocated for the initial year's implementation of RA No. 11293, and such funds necessary for its continuous and effective implementation shall thereafter be included in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA);

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11975, otherwise known as the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 GAA, specifically the Special Provision (SP) No. 5 under the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) - Office of the Secretary, provides that the amount appropriated therein for the establishment of Innovation Fund of One Hundred Million Pesos (PHP 100,000,000.00) shall be constituted as Revolving Fund - Innovation Fund to be deposited in authorized government depository banks to be used for the issuance of grants for innovation programs, activities, and projects (PAPs) in accordance with Section 21 of RA No. 11293;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned SP states that the implementation of the said provision shall be subject to the guidelines to be issued by the NEDA and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and to be confirmed by the National Innovation Council;

WHEREAS, the NEDA and the DBM have jointly developed, approved, and upon confirmation by the National Innovation Council (NIC), shall issue the implementing guidelines on the 2024 Innovation Grants, which include the types of innovation PAPs eligible for funding, the organizational structure and responsibilities, the eligibility criteria, and the administrative processes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve and confirm the NEDA-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular with the title

"Implementing Guidelines on the 2024 Innovation Grants," a copy of which is hereto attached as Annex A, to serve as the guidelines for the granting and issuance of grants to eligible entities for FY 2024.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to approve and confirm the creation of the NIC - Executive Technical Board (ETB) Subcommittee on the Approval of Modification Requests for the 2024 Innovation Grants, composed of the following: a) NIC-ETB Chairperson, and b) NIC-ETB Vice Chairpersons, which shall be responsible for the approval or disapproval of requests for line-item budget modifications amounting to One Million Pesos (PHP 1,000,000.00) or higher per request, as provided in Section VII(c) of the NEDA-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular Implementing Guidelines on the 2024 Innovation Grants.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
