**SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (REGULAR COMPONENT) SY 2024-2025
IMPLEMENTATION**

1. The Department of Education is steadfast in its commitment to tackling malnutrition among school-age children. To advance this crucial objective, the department is initiating a comprehensive feeding program that will span 160 days, prioritizing the health and well-being of young students. As part of the program, Nutritious Food Products (NFP) will be distributed directly to designated recipients within schools, ensuring access to essential nutrients to support students' growth and academic performance.
2. We hereby inform all beneficiary schools that the distribution of Nutritious Food Products (NFP) is scheduled to begin on November 4, 2024, and will continue until April 15, 2025.
3. Nutritious Food Products (NFP) will be transported to designated drop-off points within each district. A collaborative effort between the Division and District Inspectorate Team and the District Property Custodian will be in place to meticulously inspect the delivered supplies, ensuring both completeness and quality. Subsequently, a comprehensive distribution list will be prepared by the district for the subsequent allocation to individual schools.
4. The following personnel are the members of the Division Inspectorate Team who will be responsible the monitoring and inspection of the delivered Nutritious Food Products. The group assignment may be modified based on factors like personnel availability or changes to the delivery schedule.

5. The School Head or designated personnel will oversee the transportation of NFP from the designated drop-off points to their respective schools and must observe the following guidelines prior to distribution:
 - a. Ensure the quality of food products prior to distribution. Check for any signs of molds, unusual taste and smell, and any contaminants.
 - b. Food products must be given to SBFP BENEFICIARIES ONLY.
 - c. If possible, feeding should be served in the feeding area of the school except for NFPs suggested for take home.
 - d. Adhere to proper documentation protocols for the feeding program.
 - e. In the event of any potential food-related incidents, please promptly report them to the district nurse and Pepito III Villarreiz, the SBFP Focal, at the following contact number: 09173062394. Posting on social media is highly discouraged.
6. District Nurses must be present at the drop-off points during the delivery of food products to provide essential assistance and perform troubleshooting during the distribution of NFPs.
7. The Division SBFP Technical Working Group (TWG) in collaboration with District nurses will carry out periodic and random monitoring of the feeding program implementation to address any arising issues or concerns promptly while ensuring the utmost food safety and proper handling during distribution.
8. Travel expenses incurred during the transportation of food products from Drop-off points to schools will be covered by the Division SBFP Fund (SARO No. ROP-11-24-0121) while Travel expense incurred during Monitoring and Inspection will be covered by Division SBFP Program Support Fund (SARO No. ROP-11-24-0388) both are subject to standard auditing rules and regulations.






